 - □ Directors: 9







Size of Office vs. Size of Department by Recruitment Directors






Percentage of Firm-Wide Recruitment Directors




Reporting Structure: Who Law Firm Recruitment Department Reports To







Average Years of Experience in Law Firm Recruitment VS. Average Years of Overall Total Work Experience




Highest Degree of Education Attained by Law Firm Recruitment Professionals













WALRAA Average Salaries for 2003, 2006 & 2008








Average Salaries for Law School Career Services Professionals VS. Average Years of Career Services Experience




Reporting Structure: Who Career Services Department Reports To



Average Years of Experience in Law School Career Services VS. Average Years of Overall Total Work Experience




Highest Degree of Education Attained by Law School Career Services Professionals
